

Over the years, repair evolved into restoration. The Old Radio Museum displays painstakingly restored works of exotic woods-- birds-eye maple, walnut, mahogany, elm and others not seen today. 

# **Rust Relief**

A scientific test of penetrating oils from Machinist's Workshop magazine, where bolts were rusted artificially and equally, revealed the amount of torque needed to remove the nuts. Here are the results, with price per ounce:

None / 516 foot pounds /

WD-40 / 238 foot pounds / \$0.25


PB Blaster / 214 foot pounds / \$0.35

Liquid Wrench / 127 foot pounds / \$0.21

Kano Kroil / 106 foot pounds / \$0.75

ATF-Acetone mix / 53 foot pounds / \$0.10

ATF (automatic transmission fluid) with Acetone is usually mixed at 50/50. Hope this helps with your rust relief!


